Dear Ms. Owens,

DTE Electric Company hereby submits a ROP minor modification application under Rule 216(2) to ROP No: MI-ROP-B2816-2019 for Monroe Power Plant located at 3500 East Front Street in Monroe, Michigan. Enclosed are the M-001 and C-001 forms, as required. This minor modification change affects EU-UNIT1, EU-UNIT2, EU-UNIT3, and EU-UNIT4 in Section 1 of the ROP.

Pursuant to #91 of Civil Action No. 2:10-cv-13101 (ECF No. 282) filed on July 22, 2020, DTE "shall apply for amendments of their Title V Permits, to include a schedule for all Unit-specific, plant-specific, and System-specific performance, operational, maintenance, and control technology requirements established by this Consent Decree: (a) all applicable definitions from Section III and (b) all Compliance Requirements contained in Section IV."

To satisfy this requirement, DTE proposes to add a Schedule of Compliance for Monroe Power Plant to Appendix 2 of Section 1 of MI-ROP-B2816-2019. Attached is an A-001 form and the ROP Mark-Up with the proposed table for Appendix 2-1.

This application is considered timely as it is submitted by January 18, 2021 within 180 days after the date of entry of the consent decree.
