Dear Mr. Forth,

In response to your Violation Notice from November 8, 2018; we believe this violation occurred when Inductoheat installed the stack on June 30, 2006.

Inductoheat purchased the oven stack which, was sold as a kit. The standard rain cap was included in the kit. We also purchased an additional free flow rain cap and installed it in the stack. The persons that installed the stack were not aware that one section of the stack had the free flowing rain cap in it and installed the standard rain cap on as well. (6/30/2006 and ongoing)

This violation will be ongoing until we get someone out to remove the standard rain cap.

We have investigated when we purchased the stack and what was purchased. So, we already have the free flow rain cap installed in the stack already, we just need to remove the standard rain cap to correct this problem.

We are in the process of hiring someone who specializes in these stacks. So, weather and the specialists schedule permitting we would like to have this corrected by April 30, 2019. We will notify you when this is scheduled and completed.

Once the cap is removed, this will no longer exist.
