VIOLATION NOTICE

On July 7, 2014, the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Air Quality Division (AQD), received a report summarizing a stack test conducted at Marathon Petroleum Company, LP located at 1300 South Fort Street, Detroit, Michigan. Staff reviewed the results from the May 6, 2014 Zurn Boiler stack testing.

Based on a review of the stack test results, the following air pollution violation was observed:

Please initiate actions necessary to correct the cited violation and submit a written response to this Violation Notice by August 22, 2014 (which coincides with 21 calendar days from the date of this letter). The written response should include: the dates the violation occurred; an explanation of the causes and duration of the violation; whether the violation is ongoing; a summary of the actions that have been taken and are proposed to be taken to correct the violation and the dates by which these actions will take place; and what steps are being taken to prevent a reoccurrence.

If Marathon Petroleum Company, LP believes the above observations or statements are inaccurate or do not constitute violations of the applicable legal requirements cited, please provide appropriate factual information to explain your position.
