On 3/7/2014 I conducted an unannounced inspection of this facility. My contact was Mr. Rich Aldrich, plant engineer. Mr. Dave Twardokus has retired.

The plant continues to operate one shift. They now staff about 165 employees.


The facility continues operations the same as it has since my last inspection. Discussions were held regarding the burning of waste oil in the wood waste boiler. Mr. Aldrich stated he was aware of the issues with the last waste oil sample that was taken in 2012. He had discussions with Mr. Twardokus and understands that waste oil will no longer be burned. The system used to pump the waste oil onto the wood waste conveyor has been removed (this was observed and verified).

All waste oil is now shipped offsite. Records for 2013 show 3 separate shipments leaving the site: 2/11/2013, 75 gallons; 5/20/2013, 110 gallons; and 8/26/2013, 275 gallons.

In PTI # 292-96, Special Condition 33, the plant is limited to no more than 5000 pounds of adhesive per month. Records for 2013 show the *annual* adhesive usage of 5252 pounds. The plant is well below permitted limits. Mr. Aldrich stated this is due to the operation of only one shift.

No violations of PTI #292-96 or the Air Pollution Control Rules were observed during this inspection.
