Recently AQD received information from Lafarge the secondary crusher pump malfunctioned due to cold weather causing excess visible emissions and prompting a visit to the facility by Gloria Torello, AQD.

First AQD staff observed the guarry from Wessel Road and Ford Avenue. The primary crusher was operating. Minor amounts of dust could be observed at the drop point onto the pile. The distance between the drop point and top of the pile was minimized. There was dust present behind the large vehicles using the quarry roads. Torello noted there was a large steam plume off the new stack on FG KG6, and no trail off was present.

Next Torello met Josh Strapec and Bob Budink in the Large office. We talked about Lafarge's various semiannual and annual reports that are due:

Finally, Josh and Torello drove through the quarry. The primary and secondary crushers were operating. No excess visible emissions were observed. Josh said in the winter the water trucks may be used to put a fine water mist on the roads for dust control. Torello did not observe the water trucks on this visit. Josh said he tells the drivers to slow down as another method to prevent road dust.
