**RE: Violation Notice SRN: B2103 Biosolids Dryer Facility**

Dear Mr. Korniski:

This letter serves as formal notification that Great Water Authority (GLWA) has received and reviewed the Violation Notice dated June 21, 2016 regarding compliance at the Biosolids Drying Facility (BDF). The facts as stated in the Violation Notice are correct with the following exceptions:

- The maximum measure hourly SO<sub>2</sub> emissions of EUDryerTrainC during the Data Set #2 period was 1.72 lb/hr versus the 1.73 lb/hr referenced in the Violation Notice.
- During the Data Set #2 period, EUDryerTrainA had one reported hourly emissions that exceeded the permit limit versus two.

GLWA will continue to keep the Michigan Department of Environmental Quality- Air Quality Division (MDEQ-AQD) updated with the progress toward implementation of the submitted SO<sub>2</sub> Compliance Plan on a monthly basis. GLWA intends these updates to be fully informative of the plan's status. Thank you for the acknowledgment that GLWA's communication efforts to date satisfy as written response to the Violation Notice.
