This letter is in response to the violation letter that was written on September 20,2020. I will address the three sections of the violation letter.

- A) The Magnehelic pressure differential gauge was ordered and installed on October 6, 2020. It is functioning correctly.
 - 1) The Magnehelic pressure differential gauge is included on the daily inspection logs. Inspections are conducted twice a day and recorded on an inspection check list sheet.
- B) The Preventive Maintenance/Malfunction Plan (PM/MAP) was submitted on October 12, 2020. The plan shows who is in charge, and who conducts inspections as well as doing repairs and any maintenance. Also covers what extra points will be maintained t the terminal as well what inspection results will determine whether or not the unit is ready to fail.



C) All the emission calculations for the previous 12 months were submitted to the EGLE office on September 22, 2020.
1)Emissions are calculated every 15 days. There is in place an emissions calculator sheet which is recorded and entered into a book that is on the shelf in the terminal office. Book is available for inspection at any time.
