## VIOLATION NOTICE

On March 27, 2017, the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Air Quality Division (AQD), conducted an inspection of Specialty Castings LLC (Company) located at 211 Mill Street, Springport, Michigan. The purpose of this inspection was to determine the Company's compliance with the requirements of the federal Clean Air Act; Part 55, Air Pollution Control, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended (Act 451) ); the Air Pollution Control Rules; and Permit to Install (PTI) 223-09.

During the inspection, AQD staff observed the following:

7500 cfm Wheelabrator #46 MPF cartridge dust collector designated as the Wheelabrator Baghouse.	PTI 223-09, Condition EUGRINDING VIII. STACK/VENT RESTRICTIONS	The exhaust stack that comes from the Wheelabrator baghouse is discharged directly downwards towards the ground and is less than the required 18.5 feet in height.
55,000 cfm Mold Line Wheelabrator Ultra-Jet 120 TA model baghouse designated as the Main Baghouse.	PTI 223-09, Condition FGSANDHANDLING VIII. STACK/VENT RESTRICTIONS	The exhaust stack that comes from the Main baghouse is discharged horizontally and is less than the required 35.67 feet in height.
