VIOLATION NOTICE

On June 14, 2018, the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Air Quality Division (AQD), conducted an inspection of Awrey Bakeries, Inc located at 12301 Farmington Road, Livonia, Michigan. The purpose of this inspection was to determine Awrey Bakeries, Inc.'s compliance with the requirements of the federal Clean Air Act; Part 55, Air Pollution Control, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended (Act 451); the Air Pollution Control Rules; and the conditions of Permit to Install (PTI) number 197-00.

During the inspection, staff observed the following:

One 2000 KW diesel generator	PTI 197-00 Special Condition 3	A log is required to document the hours that the generator operates.
	PTI 197-00 Special Condition 5	A record of the 12-month rolling time period emissions of NOx is required.
	PTI 197-00 Special Condition 6	A request via email was sent on June 17, 2018 to Mr. Paul Faza and on June 25, 2018 to Ms. Diane Lynch and Mr. Paul Faza requesting the Sulfur content in the fuel oil used in the generator as of the writing of this letter, no response has been received regarding this request.

During this inspection, Mr. Paul Faza was unable to produce emission records, sulfur content in the fuel oil and maintenance records.

These are a violation of the recordkeeping and emission limitations specified in Special Conditions 3, 5 and 6 of PTI number 197-00.

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The conditions of PTI number 197-00 require the maintenance of records, which shall be made available for review upon request by the AQD staff.

Enclosed is a copy of the above cited permit.

Please initiate actions necessary to correct the cited violations and submit a written response to this Violation Notice by November 2, 2018 (which coincides with 21 calendar days from the date of this letter). The written response should include: the dates the violations occurred; an explanation of the causes and duration of the violations; whether the violations are ongoing; a summary of the actions that have been taken and are proposed to be taken to correct the violations and the dates by which these actions will take place; and what steps are being taken to prevent a reoccurrence.

Please submit the written response to the DEQ, AQD, Detroit District, at 3058 West Grand Blvd. Ste 2-300, Detroit, Michigan 48202 and submit a copy to Ms. Jenine Camilleri, Enforcement Unit Supervisor at the DEQ, AQD, P.O. Box 30260, Lansing, Michigan 48909-7760.

If Awrey Bakeries, Inc. believes the above observations or statements are inaccurate or do not constitute violations of the applicable legal requirements cited, please provide appropriate factual information to explain your position.
