VIOLATION NOTICE

On September 18, 2013, the Michigan Department of Environmental Quality-Air Quality Division (MDEQ-AQD) received from Romeo RIM, Inc. located at 74000 Van Dyke Avenue, Romeo, Michigan, its Renewable Operating Permit (ROP) Semi-Annual Certification and Deviation Reports and the Semi-Annual Compliance Report for 40 CFR 63, Subpart PPPP-National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants for Surface Coating of Plastic Parts and Products which were due by September 15, 2013. The purpose of these reports is to demonstrate Romeo RIM's compliance with the requirements of the federal Clean Air Act; Part 55, Air Pollution Control, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended (Act 451); the administrative rules, and the Renewable Operating Permit (ROP) number MI-ROP-B5854-2009.
