## LETTER OF VIOLATION

On December 5, 2014, the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Air Quality Division (AQD), conducted an inspection of Enterprise Iron & Metal Company, located at 850 Pannell Avenue, Grand Rapids, Michigan. The purpose of the inspection was to determine Enterprise Iron & Metal Company's compliance with the federal Clean Air Act; Part 55, Air Pollution Control, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended (Act 451); the administrative rules; and the conditions of Permit to Install (PTI) Number 168-12B.

Based upon the results of the inspection, the following air pollution violation has been identified at your facility:

Review of facility records received on March 11, 2015, show that the afterburner temperature fell below the minimum requirement of 1600 degrees Fahrenheit, based on a 3- hour block average, on 23 occasions between February 2014 and May 2014.

Please initiate actions necessary to correct the cited violation and submit a written response to this Violation Notice by April 2, 2015 (which coincides with 21 calendar days from the date of this letter). The written response should include: the dates the violation occurred; an explanation of the causes and duration of the violation; whether the violation is ongoing; a summary of the actions that have been taken and are proposed to be taken to correct the violation and the dates by which these actions will take place; and what steps are being taken to prevent a reoccurrence.
