Re: <u>Response to EGLE 05-08-19 Violation Notice</u>

EGLE Kalamazoo District and Enforcement Division:

As detailed in the Department of Energy, Great Lakes and the Environment's (EGLE) May 8th, letter, Knauf Insulation, Inc. (Knauf) Albion (Plant 12) located at 1000 E. North Street, Albion, MI conducted performance stack testing on March 19th-21st.

Testing was conducted on FG-ML2ALB and FG-WBWALBFORMING stacks. The results of all three runs of the WBWALBFORMING West Stack when combined with the WBWALBFORMING East Stack equals 5.38 lbs/ton of glass pulled (tpg). FG-WBWALBFORMING lb/tpg limit is 5.33.

In EGLE's letter, EGLE requested a response from Knauf by May 29th, 2019 detailing the following:

- 1. The dates the violation occurred;
- 2. An explanation of the causes and duration of the violations;
- 3. Whether violations are ongoing;
- 4. A summary of the actions that have been taken and are proposed to be taken to correct the violations;
- 5. The dates by which these actions will take place; and,
- 6. What steps are being taken to prevent a reoccurrence.

Knauf's response to each item are provided below for EGLE's review:
