VIOLATION NOTICE

On October 3, 2013, the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Air Quality Division (AQD), conducted a review of the ROP Semi-Annual Certification received on September 16, 2013 for the Chrysler Sterling Heights Assembly plant located at 38111 Van Dyke, Sterling Heights, Michigan. The purpose of this review was to determine compliance with the requirements of the federal Clean Air Act; Part 55, Air Pollution Control, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended (Act 451); the administrative rules and the conditions of Renewable Operating Permit (ROP) number MI-ROP-B7248-2008.

During the review, staff observed the following:

Please initiate actions necessary to correct the cited violation and submit a written response to this Violation Notice by November 6, 2013 (which coincides with 21 calendar days from the date of this letter). The written response should include: the dates the violation occurred including any dates which fall prior to the latest ROP Semi-Annual Certification; a description or example of the records that will be kept, an explanation of the causes and duration of the violation; whether the violation is ongoing; a summary of the actions that have been taken and are proposed to be taken to correct the violation and the dates by which these actions will take place; and what steps are being taken to prevent a reoccurrence.

If Chrysler Group LLC believes the above observations or statements are inaccurate or do not constitute violations of the applicable legal requirements cited, please provide appropriate factual information to explain your position. Thank you for your attention to resolving the violation cited.
