Ms. Brothers,

Evergreen Packaging received the Notice of Violation letter dated December 12, 2017. Per your request for a response to the received letter, please note the following:

- By your inspection on November 21, 2017 we were notified that we were in violation of PTI#102-07B Special Conditions VIII.
- EUPress-L stack apparently had a 'rain-cap' installed when L Press was installed in the facility on May 23, 2007. The cause of the violation can be assumed that at the time of installation of L Press, it was not known that a rain-cap was prohibited. Hence, Evergreen packing was unknowingly in violation of our air permit from May 23, 2007 to December 15, 2017.
- As of December 15, 2017, the violation is no longer ongoing. On December 15, 2017, Evergreen Packaging removed the rain cap from the L Press stack.
- Reccurrence will not be an issue as no other presses contain a rain-cap in their exhaust stacks, and no additional presses with corresponding stacks are planned. Documentation (this letter) has been filed for future reference to ensure that another violation does not occur.

With this letter, Evergreen Packaging believes that it is now in full compliance of PTI#102-07B Special Conditions VIII. Should you have any questions or concerns about the information provided, please feel free to contact me.
