

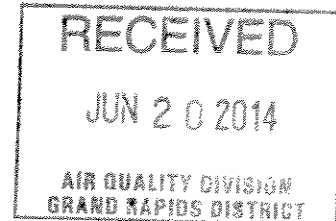

Dear Ms. Lazzaro:

Please find described herein the actions that Michigan Turkey Producers CO-OP Inc. (MTP) has taken and plans to take to address the subject Violation Notice (VN) regarding the facility wide natural gas combustion units at our production facility in Wyoming, Michigan.

1. On June 19, 2014, MTP submitted to the DEQ an application for a facility wide Permit to install (PTI). The PTI application included all of the natural gas fired combustion units and greenhouse gas emission sources. The PTI application included a request for federally enforceable emission limitations to establish the facility as a minor source and the generators as emergency use only.
2. As described in our June 10, 2014 letter to you, effective September 2013 none of the Caterpillar engines have operated as co-generation units and none will operate as co-generation units going forward. The sole function of each of the five natural gas fired emergency generators is now and will continue to be to provide back-up power to the facility when power from the local utility is interrupted.

3. MTP will comply with all of the NESHAP and NSPS regulatory requirements as they apply to each of the emergency generator reciprocating internal combustion engines (RICE) as described in Table 4 of the air permit application. In addition, MTP will comply with the provisions of the air permit once it is issued.

Again, thank you for your assistance in helping us resolve these issues. MTP will continue to work diligently to correct all outstanding issues in a timely fashion and will strive to ensure ongoing compliance.
