

## **VIOLATION NOTICE**

On March 12, 2015, the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Air Quality Division (AQD), conducted an inspection of Buckeye Terminals (Facility), located at 2303 South 3rd Street, Niles, Michigan. The purpose of this inspection was to determine the Facility's compliance with the requirements of the federal Clean Air Act; Part 55, Air Pollution Control, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended (Act 451); the administrative rules; and the conditions of Permit to Install (PTI) No. 384-98 and 194-10.

During the inspection, staff of the AQD observed the following:

Process Description	Rule/Permit Condition Violated	Comments
90,000 Gallon Butane Storage Tank/Vessel	Rule 336.1201 (Rule 201) PTIs	The Facility installed a 90,000 gallon butane storage tank/vessel in 2014 without first obtaining a PTI.

Please initiate actions necessary to correct the cited violation and submit a written response to this Violation Notice by April 24, 2015. The written response should include: the dates the violation occurred; an explanation of the causes and duration of the violation; whether the violation is ongoing; a summary of the actions that have been taken and are proposed to be taken to correct the violation and the dates by which these actions will take place; and what steps are being taken to prevent a reoccurrence.

If the Facility believes the above observations or statements are inaccurate or do not constitute violations of the applicable legal requirements cited, please provide appropriate factual information to explain your position.

Thank you for your attention to resolving the violation cited above and for the cooperation that was extended to me during my inspection of the Facility.
