VIOLATION NOTICE

On May 27, 2021, the Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE), Air Quality Division (AQD), conducted an inspection of Troy Dry Cleaners, 1629 Garfield Road, Port Huron, Michigan. The purpose of this inspection was to determine Troy Dry Cleaners' compliance with the requirements of the federal Clean Air Act and Part 55, Air Pollution Control, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended (Act 451).

Specifically, this dry cleaner is subject to the federal National Perchloroethylene Air Emission Standards for Dry Cleaning Facilities, Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations (CFR), Part 63, Subpart M and the Public Health Code, 1978 PA 368, as amended, Dry Cleaning Establishment Rules Utilizing Class I, II, III, and IV Solvents. According to our investigation, Troy Dry Cleaners owns the facility and Mid Michigan Laundry & Drycleaning Equipment Corporation installed the equipment at the facility. The Dry Cleaning Establishment Rules Utilizing Class I, II, III, and IV Solvents holds both the owner and the installer equally liable for the installation violation.

During the inspection, staff observed the following:

Commercial, Dry to Dry, Type IIIA Hydrocarbon dry cleaning facility	R 325.17202(a,c)	The dry cleaning establishment was modified without prior notification, plans, or approval (installed a dry cleaning machine).
Commercial, Dry to Dry, Type IV Perchloroethylene dry cleaning facility	40 CFR 63.322(m)	There is a perc vapor leak (194ppm) at the lint filter door on the Union dry cleaning machine.

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Please initiate actions necessary to correct the cited violations and submit a written response to this Violation Notice by June 25, 2021 (which coincides with 21 calendar days from the date of this letter). The written response should include: the dates the violations occurred; an explanation of the causes and duration of the violations; whether the violations are ongoing; a summary of the actions that have been taken and are proposed to be taken to correct the violations and the dates by which these actions will take place; and what steps are being taken to prevent a reoccurrence.

If Troy Dry Cleaners, and Mid Michigan Laundry & Drycleaning Equipment Corporation believe the above observations or statements are inaccurate or do not constitute violations of the applicable legal requirements cited, please provide appropriate factual information to explain your position.
