ASTI is submitting this letter on behalf of Fendt Builder's Supply to respond to the Michigan Department of Environmental Great Lakes and Energy (EGLE) correspondence dated September 23, 2020 and the site visit on August 28, 2020. The purpose of this inspection was to determine Fendt Builder's Supply's compliance with the requirements of the federal Clean Air Act; Part 55, Air Pollution Control, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended (Act 451); the Air Pollution Control Rules; and the conditions of Permit to Install (PTI) number 244-98A.

Fendt Builder's Supply has contracted with ASTI to prepare this response to the NOV.

NOTICE OF VIOLATION REGARDING BOILER EXHAUST STACKS

The EGLE letter states: During this inspection, AQD staff observed that the exhaust gases from SVBOILERS are obstructed by a conical rain cap. The stack and vent restrictions per PTI No. 244-98A, SVBOILERS VII specify that the exhaust gases from the stack shall be discharged unobstructed vertically upwards to the ambient air unless otherwise noted. The conical rain cap obstructs the vertical upwards discharge.

Fendt Builder's Supply response: An application for a PTI will be prepared and submitted to include the rain caps on the exhaust stacks for the two boilers.
