I (glm) performed a scheduled inspection at this facility and found it to be in compliance with the air rules.

This is a minor source in Ubly and is an edible dry-beans elevator. This plant was formerly operated as one of the Wruble Elevators in the Thumb. It occasionally hands grains and corn, but the main commodity is edible beans. The plant became ADM in 1997. I met with Terry Cramer, plant manager. The previous plant manager, John Schmidt, has retired since the last inspection.

Terry provided a tour of the grounds including the maintenance facility. The facility is approximately 1.8 million bushel capacity and it mainly handles only dry beans and stores some fertilizer on site for CPS (Crop Production Services) in Ubly. The facility does load out to rail car, but mainly operates 3 unloading/receiving pits. While the bean harvest is going on currently, there was little activity at the time of my visit.

The facility has a couple of dryers that are exempt from permitting, R285 (o). The plant does have a bag house connected to it. Since the farmers have gone to direct cut the amount of dirt/dust coming into the plant has decreased.

The grounds and the plant in general are very well kept. The AQD has not received any complaints about this elevator.
