I (EC) performed an unannounced inspection at this facility (10/28/24) and found it to be in compliance with applicable Air Rules.

This is a minor source in the town of Ubly. This location serves as an edible dry bean elevator. They also occasionally bring in grain and corn.

I (EC) arrived at the office at approximately 10:45am. I entered the office and was greeted by Terry Cramer, the plant manager. Terry provided a brief tour of the facility. The capacity of the facility still remains at 1.8 million bushels, in 3 concrete silos and 7 steel silos. Fertilizer is not stored on site by ADM. ADM is operating 3 receiving/unloading pits for commercial and private (local farmer) trucking. ADM does still transport some beans by rail. ADM maintains 1 baghouse and 2 cyclones to manage dust and other particulate matter from the beans/grain/corn. The facility has dryers, but according to Rule 285 (p). It did not sound like any equipment was running during my time on site.

The grounds of the facility seemed well kept and the plant manager reported that they manage dust by applying brine when needed. There was no truck traffic occurring during my visit. There are no AQD complaints on file for ADM Edible Beans Specialties.

I departed the facility at approximately 10:55am.
