## **VIOLATION NOTICE**

On September 3, 2015, the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Air Quality Division (AQD), conducted an inspection of State Crushing - East, Inc. located at 25501 Sherwood Avenue, Warren, Michigan. The purpose of this inspection was to determine State Crushing - East's compliance with the requirements of the federal Clean Air Act; Part 55, Air Pollution Control, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended (Act 451); the administrative rules; and the conditions of Permit to Install (PTI) number 154-12 for a nonmetallic mineral crushing plant.

During the inspection, staff observed the following:

Nonmetallic Mineral Crushing	Appendix B-Fugitive Dust Control Plan of PTI Number 154-12	Plant is not maintaining records of water applications to the plant yard, plant roadways, or storage piles as required by Conditions I.A and II.B of the plant's Fugitive Dust Control Plan (Appendix B of PTI Number 154-12)
Nonmetallic Mineral Crushing	Special Condition IX under EUPROCESS.	Plant has not labeled any of its process equipment using the ID Numbers in Appendix A of PTI Number 154-12.

During this inspection, State Crushing - East was unable to produce records of the water applications to the plant's roadways, the plant yard, or plant storage piles. This is a violation of the recordkeeping requirements specified in Conditions I.A and II.B of the plant's Fugitive Dust Control Plan (Appendix B) of PTI number 154-12. The conditions

of PTI number 154-12 require water application records to be made available for review upon request from AQD staff.

It was also determined that State Crushing - East had not labeled any of its process equipment as required by Special Condition IX under EUPROCESS using the ID Numbers in Appendix A of PTI Number 154-12.

Enclosed is a copy of the above cited PTI.

Please initiate actions necessary to correct the cited violations and submit a written response to this Violation Notice by October 1, 2015 (which coincides with 21 calendar days from the date of this letter). The written response should include: the dates the violations occurred; an explanation of the causes and duration of the violations; whether the violations are ongoing; a summary of the actions that have been taken and are proposed to be taken to correct the violations and the dates by which these actions will take place; and what steps are being taken to prevent a reoccurrence.

If State Crushing - East believes the above observations or statements are inaccurate or do not constitute violations of the applicable legal requirements cited, please provide appropriate factual information to explain your position.

Thank you for your attention to resolving the violations cited above and for the cooperation that was extended to me during my inspection of State Crushing - East.
