SECOND VIOLATION NOTICE

On October 16, 2015, the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Air Quality Division (AQD), conducted an inspection of State Crushing – East, Inc. located at 25501 Sherwood Avenue, Warren, Michigan. The purpose of the inspection was to determine State Crushing – East's compliance with the requirements of the federal Clean Air Act; and Part 55, Air Pollution Control, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended (Act 451); the administrative rules, the conditions of Permit to Install (PTI) number 154-12, and to investigate recent complaints which we received on October 6, 2015 and October 12, 2015 regarding fugitive dust attributed to State Crushing – East's operations. During the inspection, AQD staff requested water application records required by PTI 154-12 EUPROCESS Special Condition III. 2, EUTRUCKTRAFFIC Special Condition III.1, EUSTORAGE Special Condition III. 1, and Appendix B, I. A.

On September 10, 2015, the AQD sent the company a Violation Notice citing a violation discovered as a result of the inspection conducted on September 3, 2015. Your written response received on September 30, 2015 stated "We are currently keeping a log book of each application of water." A copy of that letter is enclosed for your reference. As of this date, we have not received the records of water applications at State Crushing – East, mentioned in the response letter and requested during the October 16, 2015 inspection.

Please be advised that failure to submit in writing verification of the actions the company has reported it has taken to resolve the cited violation may result in escalated enforcement action by the AQD. Please provide the watering records mentioned in the September 30, 2015 response letter by December 1, 2015, which corresponds to 14 days from the date of this letter.

Be further advised that issuance of this Violation Notice does not preclude or limit the DEQ's ability to initiate any other enforcement action under state or federal law as appropriate.
