VIOLATION NOTICE

On August 16, 2013, the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Air Quality Division (AQD), issued Cargill-Ag Horizons (Facility), located at 201 South George Street, Decatur, Michigan, Permit to Install (PTI) No. 103-13. Condition V.1&2 of Table FGGRain of this PTI requires testing of any New Source Performance Standards (NSPS) sources within 180 days of the commencement of operation. As of February 12, 2014, the testing has not been performed.

This results in the following violation:

North Rail Loadout 1 (NRL1)	PTI No. 103-13 FGGRain, Condition V.1, and 40 CFR, Part 60 Subpart A (60.8(a))	The Facility has not tested for compliance with the NSPS opacity limit within 180 days of starting operation.


Please initiate actions necessary to correct the cited violations and submit a written response to this Violation Notice by March 6, 2014. The written response should include: the dates the violations occurred; an explanation of the causes and duration of the violations; whether the violations are ongoing; a summary of the actions that have been taken and are proposed to be taken to correct the violations and the dates by which these actions will take place; and what steps are being taken to prevent a reoccurrence.

If the Facility believes the above observations or statements are inaccurate or do not constitute violations of the applicable legal requirements cited, please provide appropriate factual information to explain your position.
