On April 27, 2021, Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes and Energy-Air Quality Division (EGLE-AQD) staff, I (Shamim Ahammod) conducted an onsite schedule inspection of Pontiac Municipal Cemeteries (SRN: M4270) located at 6180 DIXIE HWY, CLARKSTON, Michigan. The purpose of the inspection was to determine the company's compliance with the requirements of the federal Clean Air Act; Part 55, Air Pollution Control, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended (Act 451); the Air Pollution Control Rules; and the conditions of PTI Nos. 62-70I and and 16-85I.

Permit History and Source Description

On February 25, 1983, Permit to Install (PTI) No. 62-70I was issued for the installation and operation of the 300 pounds per hour Types O and 4 waste incinerators using a secondary burner.

On March 25, 1987, Permit to Install (PTI) No. 16-85I was issued for the installation and operation of the 150 pounds per hour Types 1 and 4 Industrial Equipment and Engineering Company incinerator with a secondary burner.

MACES records

On 2/28/2011, AQD received vendor document from permittee that appears to confirm that the power supply and gas supply have been disconnected from both incinerators.

On 01/11/2011, AQD staff received voice mail message that incinerators have been permanently disconnected.

Inspection Arrangement

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, I prearranged this announced inspection on April 27, 2021.

Onsite Inspection

On April 27, 2021, at 1:10 PM, I arrived at the facility and was greeted by Mr. Larry Earl Robinson, Building Superintendent of City of Pontiac. Mr. Robinson's Phone number is 248-

758-3613 and email address is LRobinson@pontiac.mi.us. I introduced myself, provided credentials, and stated the purpose of the inspection.

During the inspection I observed the fuel and electrical supply lines were disconnected from both incinerators (Types 1 and 4 Industrial Equipment & Engineering Company incinerator and Types O & 4 waste incinerator). I took several pictures showing that fuel and electrical supply lines have been disconnected from both incinerators. Pictures are attached to this report.

Based on the onsite inspection, it is determined that the Pontiac Municipal Cemeteries is no longer using the emissions unit on this site and this permit should be voided. I will send an email request to Ms. Sue Thelen, of the AQD Permit Section, to void the PTI Nos. 62-70I and and16-85I. Hence, compliance with applicable requirements was not determined.




Image 1(Incinerators): fuel and electrical supply lines have been disconnected from both incinerators
