## **VIOLATION NOTICE**

On September 17, 2014, the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Air Quality Division (AQD), conducted an inspection of the Otsego Lake 34 CPF located at SE¼ NE¼, Section 34, Otsego Lake Township, Michigan. The purpose of this inspection was to determine Merit Energy Company's compliance with the requirements of the federal Clean Air Act; Part 55, Air Pollution Control, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended (Act 451); the administrative rules and the conditions of Permit to Install (PTI) number 327-07A.

During the inspection, staff observed the following:

Process Description	Rule/Permit Condition Violated	Comments
Flare	General Condition No. 11 and Rule 301(1)(a)	Visible emissions from the flare were greater than 20 percent opacity

During this inspection it was noted that the flare was emitting opacity in excess of emissions allowed by Act 451, Rule 301.

Enclosed are copies of the instantaneous and six-minute average readings taken at the flare.

Please initiate actions necessary to correct the cited violation and submit a written response to this Violation Notice by October 16, 2014. The written response should include: the dates the violation occurred; an explanation of the causes and duration of the violation; whether the violation is ongoing; a summary of the actions that have been taken and are proposed to be taken to correct the violation and the dates by which these actions will take place; and what steps are being taken to prevent a reoccurrence.

If Merit Energy Company believes the above observations or statements are inaccurate or do not constitute violations of the applicable legal requirements cited, please provide appropriate factual information to explain your position.
