<b>RESOLVED COMPLAINTS:</b>		

Air Quality Division (AQD) staff Adam Shaffer (AS) completed an odor survey and site review of the QG Printing II LLC (QG) on September 2, 2020. This was to verify the catalytic oxidizer (CO) previously identified to not be operating properly has been replaced and is in operation (the unit was replaced the week of June 22<sup>nd</sup>) and to verify odors (odor complaint received on May 27, 2020) have been addressed.

AS arrived in the area at 11:20am. Weather conditions at the time were partly cloudy skies, winds from the west at 10-15mph and temperatures in the low 70°s F. Prior to this AS had spoken with QG staff Dan Nichols, Production Support Manager, to verify the CO was in operation and controlling emissions from the greatest number of presses. It was confirmed the CO was running and controlling emissions from two presses which would be the same number of presses operating when odors were identified by AS on June 18, 2020. Upon arriving in the area, AS completed an odor survey of areas downwind of the QG site. Odors noted previously that would have appeared to be coming from the CO had a solvent type smell. Minor odors consisting of fresh ink and a plant like odor were identified, however, no solvent odors were noted.

Upon completing the odor survey, AS contacted and met with Mr. Nichols to relay the findings. A call was made to include QG staff Ms. Lacey Schucht, Regional Corporate Environmental Coordinator, for a brief meeting on the findings and any additional information needed moving forward. Following this AS and Mr. Nichols proceeded to the rooftop to view the new CO. It was verified the new CO was installed and in operation. No solvent odors were noted downwind of the new CO on the rooftop. AS left the QG site shortly after that.

Based on the September 2, 2020, odor survey and site review of the facility, no further action is necessary regarding the Violation Notice dated February 6, 2020. Additionally, based on the observations made, it appears that the May 27, 2020 odor complaint has been addressed.
