On March 5, 2018, I, Joseph Forth, Michigan Department of Environmental Quality-Air Quality Division (MDEQ-AQD) Staff, conducted a self-initiated inspection at Ros's Cabinets. The facility is located at 15065 32 Mile Rd, Romeo, MI 48065. For the inspection, I was accompanied by AQD inspectors Adam Bognar and Lauren Magirl. The purpose of the inspection was to determine the facility's compliance with the Federal Clean Air Act; Article II, Part 55, Air Pollution Control of Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 Public Act 451, as amended, MDEQ-AQD Air Pollution Rules, and Permit to Install No. 130-15.

We arrived at the facility at 1:45 pm. We were met by Mike Loiacono, Foreman for Ros's Cabinets. We introduced ourselves, provided our credentials, and stated the purpose of the inspection. Mr. Loiacono explained to us that the facility had liquidated all of it's equipment and had removed it from the facility. He said that the company had originally planned to move to a different location, but the owner changed their mind and decided to sell off the assets and the company. We were taken into the back of the building where the paint spray booths and other equipment used to be. The equipment had in fact been removed completely from the building. All equipment, not just that which was permitted had been removed. I thanked Mr. Loiacono and said we would look around outside the building before leaving.


We walked around the outside of the building to see if the facility had left any coating containers or equipment around the perimeter of the building. There were two large boxes with various paints and coatings, but the boxes were lined with plastic and appeared to be waiting to be picked up for waste disposal. This was not confirmed with the facility.

We left the facility at 2:15 pm.

**Compliance**

The facility appears to be compliant with the federal Clean Air Act, Part 55, Air Pollution Control of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 Public Act 451; Michigan Department of Environmental Quality, Air Quality Division (MDEQ-AQD) rules.

The process originally permitted by PTI No. 130-15 is no longer taking place and the equipment is no longer at the location. An email was sent to the permit section of AQD to void PTI No. 130-15 (see attached).
