On February 20, 2019 AQD staff traveled to Grand Traverse County to perform an inspection of Kennemetal Inc. The purpose of the inspection was to determine the facility's compliance with Permit to Install No. 192-87 and applicable state and federal air pollution control regulations. AQD staff noted that the facility permit consists of polyurethane sandblasting nozzle manufacturing operations equipment.

AQD staff arrived on site at 9:10 a.m. to snowy conditions with a temperature of 24°F with a SE wind of 6 mph. There were no noticeable odors upon arrival.

AQD staff met with Mr. Keith Kopriva who provided a tour of the facility and answered all questions. The facility consists of two buildings with permitted equipment in the main building. The following discusses the results of the inspection and on-site review of records.

At time of inspection, there were no visible emissions from the polyurethane sandblasting nozzle manufacturing operations. Exhaust filters were in place and operating properly on the paint spray booth. Exhaust gasses from the equipment are being discharged unobstructed vertically upwards to the ambient air from a stack that appeared to be 40 feet above ground. Records provided by Mr. Keith Kopriva showed that the total VOC emissions were 0.651 tons/year and 0.46 lb/hr. At the time of inspection, all permit requirements appear to be in compliance.
