SECOND VIOLATION NOTICE

On March 22, 2016, the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Air Quality Division (AQD) conducted an inspection of Lapeer Plating and Plastics (LPP) located at 395 Demille Road, Lapeer.

The purpose of the inspection was to determine your facility's compliance with the requirements of the federal Clean Air Act; and Part 55, Air Pollution Control, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended (Act 451); the Air Pollution Control Rules; and Title 40 Code of Federal Regulations Part 63 (40CFR63), Subpart N; Consent Order AQD No. 27-2015; the administrative rules and the conditions of Permit to Install (PTI) number 25-13; and General Permit 11-33.

On March 28, 2016, the AQD sent the company a Violation Notice citing violations discovered as a result of the inspection and requested your written response by April 25, 2016. A copy of that letter is enclosed for your reference. As of this date, we have received an incomplete response to the outstanding violations regarding the tracking of Hazardous Air Pollutants (HAPs). The original response stated that HAP tracking would be complete by May 18, 2016. These violations are cited as numbers 6 and 7 in the violation dated March 28, 2016 and identified below.

Please be advised that failure to respond in writing and identifying actions the company will take or has taken to resolve the cited violations may result in escalated enforcement action by the AQD. Please provide the information requested in our March 28, 2016 letter by June 8, 2017, which corresponds to 13 days from the date of this letter.

Be further advised that issuance of this Violation Notice does not preclude or limit the DEQ's ability to initiate any other enforcement action under state or federal law as appropriate.
