I visited the facility conduct an inspection and determine compliance with existing permits. The files contained one active permit for the Memtron facility located on Johnson Street in Frankenmuth. For the inspection I met with Mr. Mark Maxson, General Manager. Memtron Technologies was acquired by Esterline in early 2000.

PTI 1053-89 was issued for a printing and curing line in 1991. This equipment was initially installed at the 1400 Weiss Street location. Those operations were moved to 530 N. Franklin Street in 1991. The permitted equipment was moved at that time, but has since been removed and replaced. Memtron currently operates ten separate screen printing lines. Four of the lines operate a gas fired dryer, which is vented to the atmosphere. Five of the lines operate a UV curing station. These operations are exempt under R287(e).

Memtron provided records of annual usage of inks and thinners used at the facilities. Records indicated an annual usage of approximately 500 gallons inks and thinners.

In addition to the printing operations, there are assembly and quality control areas. The facility was in compliance.
