The building is divided into two suites by landlord Etkin Real-estate Solutions of Southfield: While Suite 100 is occupied by Inteva, Suite 150 is occupied by Entertainment (HSP EPI Acquisition, LLC), both digital and paper coupons publishing company.

On March 17, 2016, I conducted a level 2 self-initiated inspection of Inteva Products, LLC. ("Inteva"), located at 1401 Crooks Road, Suite 100, Troy, Michigan 48084. The inspection was conducted to determine compliance with the Federal Clean Air Act; Article II, Part 55, Air Pollution Control, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451; and Michigan Department of Environmental Quality, Air Quality Division (MDEQ-AQD) administrative rules.

During the FY 2016 inspection, Mr. Carl Sieczkowski (Phone: 248-655-0731; Fax: 248-655-8455; Cell: NA; E-mail: cSieczkowski@IntevaProducts.com), Shipping and Receiving, assisted me. The purpose of inspection was to inspect a company that has not been inspected for over a decade by DEQ-AQD.

About 2008, Inteva purchased part of Delphi business out of bankruptcy. About 400 people

are employed by Inteva at this Troy site. This is not a manufacturing facility. Inteva conducts R & D, engineering, testing, prototyping operations at this site. This building also serves as World Headquarters. Inteva has many strictly automotive product lines:

- 1. Closure systems
- 2. Interior systems
- 3. Motors and electronics
- 4. Roof systems

There are several testing, prototyping, etc. equipment / processes are present:

- 1. Twin screw extruder
- 2. Underwater palletizer
- 3. Roving booth
- 4. Dosing platform
- 5. Extrusion compression molding with in-line compounding
- 6. Laser etching
- 7. Environmental chambers (about 25) where materials are tested for cold (-50 °C), hot (120 °C), humidity (20-95 % RH)
- 8. Van Dorn injection for prototyping
- 9. Testing lab
- 10. Tool shop (3 lathes and 2 bridge port machines)
- 11. Sunroof prototyping and leak testing
- 12. Rain, glass anti-pinch testing

All equipment / processes are exempt from Rule 336.1201 (Permit-to-Install) pursuant to Rule 336.1283 (or 336.1285) because all work is R&D, testing, prototyping.

Conclusion

Inteva purchased a part of Delphi business out of bankruptcy. This Troy building serves as World Headquarters for Inteva. Only R&D, testing, engineering, prototyping work is done in Troy facility. All equipment / processes are exempt from Rule 336.1201 (Permit-to-Install) pursuant to Rule 336.1283 (or 336.1285) because all work is R&D, testing, prototyping.
