On Wednesday, September 4, 2019 Caryn Owens of the Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE)-Air Quality Division (AQD) attempted to conduct a scheduled field inspection of Woodland Oil – East 8<sup>th</sup> Street site (SRN: N2820), located at 501 East 8<sup>th</sup> Street in Traverse City. More specifically, the site is located on the north side of East 8<sup>th</sup> Street, on the northeast corner of Wellington and East 8<sup>th</sup> Street. The field inspection was to determine if there was equipment still located onsite associated with the Permit to Install (PTI) 181-91B.

PTI 181-91B was issued for a soil vapor extraction system to remediate soils contaminated by an underground storage tank leak from 1995. Based on the field inspection and EGLE – Remediation Redevelopment Division (RRD) records, the remediation system has been removed from the Property. The former location of the remediation system now includes an addition to the building and is a walk-in cooler for the convenience store. Therefore, based on this information the remediation system has been removed from the specific terms of the facility and therefore, PTI 181-91A can be voided, and no further action is necessary at this time.
