**VIOLATION NOTICE**

On March 2, 2020, the Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE), Air Quality Division (AQD), received correspondence from Sheridan Publishing Grand Rapids, Inc. (Sheridan Publishing) located at 5100 33<sup>rd</sup> Street SE in Cascade Township, Michigan. Information contained in the letter was used to determine Sheridan Publishing's compliance with the requirements of the federal Clean Air Act; Part 55, Air Pollution Control, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended; the Air Pollution Control Rules; and Permit to Install No. 114-13.

Based on the correspondence, the following violations are documented:

| Web heatset printing press (T-32) | Rule 201                       | The permittee installed a single web heatset press without obtaining a permit to install. |
| Web heatset printing press (T-48) | Rule 201                       | The permittee installed a single web heatset press without obtaining a permit to install. |

In the letter from Sheridan Publishing, the company indicated that two multi-web heatset presses (M-1000 and M-120) were removed and replaced with one single web heatset press (T-32) and one single web UV press (T-48). These replacement presses were installed in 2019 and utilize less materials and have a lower associated emissions potential than the previous presses. Emissions from these units are also controlled by a regenerative thermal oxidizer. On March 9, 2020 a permit to install application was submitted to the AQD to address the installation of the new equipment. Because of this, an additional compliance plan will not be required at this time.
