On 2/11/2015, I conducted an unannounced inspection of this facility. My contact was the shop mechanic, Mr. Mike St Andre.

Burton Excavating was issued PTI #33-91 for a Shenandoah Waste Oil furnace, Model #WO-F200, on 5/14/1991. The only compliance documentation in the file is a letter from Burton Excavating dated 8/7/1995, stating they burn approximately 2500 gallons per year.

During my inspection, Mr. St. Andre stated they continue to burn waste oil generated by their equipment. No oil is collected from off-site. The furnace has been replaced and they now have a Clean burn Model #CB-2800. Mr. St. Andre stated the furnace had quit working about a month ago but they plan to repair it and continue its use.

This facility will qualify for an exemption from Rule 201 and the requirement to obtain a PTI under Rule 282(b)(iv).

PTI #33-91 will be voided and the facility will continue to operate their waste oil furnace. A site inspection should be conducted at a later date and a sample of the waste oil should be obtained and analyzed to ensure the facility is not burning materials that do not meet the specifications of waste oil.
