On August 3, 2018, I, Joseph Forth, Michigan Department of Environmental Quality-Air Quality Division (MDEQ-AQD) Staff, conducted a scheduled inspection at Mobil Oil Corporation (N3447) located at 45014 Cass Rd, MI 48317. The purpose of the inspection was to determine the facility's compliance with, the Federal Clean Air Act; Article II, Part 55, Air Pollution Control of Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 Public Act 451, and Permit to Install (PTI) No. 207-92.

I arrived at the facility at 2:00 pm. The location is no longer Mobil Oil. There is no building with the same address as what is on the permit anymore. I walked around the property to look for any remediation equipment, which I did not find. There is a gas station near where the permitted gas station would have been, Shamrock. I looked around these locations to see if there was any remediation and saw no such equipment in the vicinity.

I left the area at 2:25 pm.

I spoke with Remediation and Redevelopment Division (RRD) Geologist Brandon Alger who was not able to find any additional information in the RRD records.

Compliance

The facility appears to be compliant with the federal Clean Air Act, Part 55, Air Pollution Control of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 Public Act 451; Michigan Department of Environmental Quality, Air Quality Division (MDEQ-AQD) rules.

The process originally permitted by PTI No. 207-92 is no longer taking place and the equipment is no longer at the location. An email was sent to the permit section of AQD to void PTI No. 1070-92 (see attached).
