I wanted to give you a update on what has transpired. I have talked with the plant operators in Lawrence and they have been working on the repairs since your last visit.

There are no records of amount of materials produced in Lawrence. All records as you and I discussed are here in Plainwell. The person that had been taking care of the records you needed was Mrs Bailey. She no longer works here. And the fact that these were to be turned in on a monthly basis had not been made aware to me. Or more importantly to Hannah. We assure you hopefully this changes immediately.
