On June 11, 2019, I conducted a scheduled inspection of what was previously Amoco Service station #5406 at 8100 Hall Road, Utica, Michigan. The facility has a State Registration Number (SRN) of N3838. Amoco was permitted in 1993 for a soil vapor extraction and air sparging system with biofilter and carbon adsorption control. The purpose of this inspection was to determine the facility's compliance with the requirements of the Federal Clean Air Act; Article II, Part 55, Air Pollution Control, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended (Act 451); the administrative rules; and Permit to Install (PTI) No. 398-93 and PTI No. 398-93a.

Prior to the site visit, I spoke with Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy Remediation and Redevelopment Division staff Emily Bertolini about whether she was aware of the existence of any soil vapor extraction systems on site. Based on their records, the site was closed for remediation in 1998.

I arrived on site, which is now a BP gas station, and looked around the gas station lot. There was not any indication of a soil vapor recovery system on site. I went inside and spoke with the gas station attendant. I explained that there was a soil vapor extraction system on site that was permitted in 1993 and that I was there to confirm whether this piece of equipment was still on site and operating. The attendant said that the current gas station was built in 2005 on a vacant lot and that he had no knowledge of any sort of equipment on site.

Based on the information from RRD and the site visit, it appears that the site is no longer operating and PTI No. 398-93 and PTI No. 398-93 a should be voided.
