**VIOLATION NOTICE**

On April 27, 2022, the Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE), Air Quality Division (AQD), conducted an inspection of Industrial Stripping Services located at 2235 29<sup>th</sup> Street SE, Grand Rapids, Michigan. The purpose of this inspection was to determine Industrial Stripping Services compliance with the requirements of the federal Clean Air Act; Part 55, Air Pollution Control, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended (Act 451); the Air Pollution Control Rules; and the conditions of Permit to Install (PTI) numbers 574-97 and 168-01.

During the inspection, staff observed the following:

Process Description	Rule/Permit Condition Violated	Comments
Burn-off Oven	Rule 201	Failure to obtain a Permit to Install

During this inspection, it was noted that Industrial Stripping Services had installed and commenced operation of unpermitted equipment at this facility. The AQD staff advised Industrial Stripping Services on April 27, 2022, that this is a violation of Rule 201 of the administrative rules promulgated under Act 451.

A program for compliance may include a completed PTI application for the burn-off oven process equipment. An application form is available by request, or at the following website: [www.michigan.gov/egle/about/organization/air-quality/air-permits](http://www.michigan.gov/egle/about/organization/air-quality/air-permits).

Be advised that Rule 201 requires that a permit be obtained prior to installation, construction, operation, reconstruction, relocation, or alteration of any process or process equipment which may be a source of an air contaminant.


Please initiate actions necessary to correct the cited violation and submit a written response to this Violation Notice by May 25, 2022 (which coincides with 21 calendar days from the date of this letter). The written response should include: the dates the violation occurred; an explanation of the causes and duration of the violation; whether the violation is ongoing; a summary of the actions that have been taken and are proposed to be taken to correct the violation and the dates by which these actions will take place; and what steps are being taken to prevent a reoccurrence.

Please submit the written response to EGLE, AQD, Grand Rapids District, at 350 Ottawa Avenue NW, Unit 10, Grand Rapids, Michigan 49503 and submit a copy to Jenine Camilleri, Enforcement Unit Supervisor at EGLE, AQD, P.O. Box 30260, Lansing, Michigan 48909-7760.

If Industrial Stripping Services believes the above observations or statements are inaccurate or do not constitute violations of the applicable legal requirements cited, please provide appropriate factual information to explain your position.
