SUBJECT: National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants: Halogenated Solvent Cleaning

## VIOLATION NOTICE

Records of the Air Quality Division (AQD), Michigan Department of Environmental Quality, indicate that your facility, located at 8220 Old White Lake Road, White Lake, Michigan includes equipment that is subject to the National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants for Halogenated Solvent Cleaning, 40 CFR Part 63, Subpart T. This rule regulates solvent cleaning machines that use any solvent containing methylene chloride, perchloroethylene, trichloroethylene, 1,1,1-trichloroethane, carbon tetrachloride or chloroform, or any combination of these halogenated HAP solvents, in a total concentration greater than 5 percent by weight, as a cleaning and/or drying agent.

In accordance with 40 CFR Part 63, Subpart T, Section 63.468(f), (g) and (h), an annual compliance report is due by February 1 following the year for which the reporting is being made. An exceedance report is due by the 30<sup>th</sup> day following the end of the calendar half or quarter, as appropriate. Each owner of a regulated solvent cleaner shall submit an exceedance report semiannually except when more frequent reporting is necessary to accurately assess the compliance status of the source. The AQD has not received an annual compliance report and or exceedance report/s for the period from January 1, 2010 through February 1, 2015 for each regulated machine at your facility. You are hereby notified that failure to submit the required reports constitutes a violation of this federal rule.

Please submit the annual compliance report and or exceedance reports within 14 days of receipt of this letter. Notwithstanding your response to the preceding citation, the AQD may initiate further enforcement action to address violations of state and federal Air Acts, rules, and regulations.
