On 10/08/2015, I conducted an unannounced level 2 target inspection at Mel Farr Imports located at 1765 South Telegraph Road, Bloomfield Hills, Michigan. The purpose of the inspection was to determine the facility's compliance with the requirements of the federal Clean Air Act; Part 55, Air Pollution Control, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended (Act 451), and the administrative rules.

During the file review process, I found out that the facility was an automotive dealership and the facility became Toyota of Bloomfield in 2001. The air quality concern at that time was the use of halogenated degreaser in its service and repair facility.


During this inspection, I found out that the facility have been completely empty and abandoned. I observed a building at the center of the lot and another building at the back south corner but empty and in rundown condition. The paved lots around the buildings were also in rundown condition with grass growths all over showing signs that the facility have been abandoned for years.

As a result of my inspection, I will note in the AQD MACES database system that this facility is permanently closed.
