VIOLATION NOTICE

On March 9, 2016, the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Air Quality Division (AQD), conducted an inspection of Enviro Tech Coatings located at 1900 Austin Street, Midland, Michigan. The purpose of this inspection was to determine Enviro Tech Coatings' compliance with the requirements of the federal Clean Air Act; Part 55, Air Pollution Control, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended (Act 451); the Air Pollution Control Rules; and the conditions of Permit to Install (PTI) number 52-00C.

During the inspection, staff observed the following:

Spray Booth 1	PTI 52-00C FGSPRAYBOOTHS I.2	Pounds per month VOC limit was exceeded (2,717 vs 2,000)
FGFACILITY	Permit 52-00C FGFACILITY VI.2(e)	Records were unavailable for individual hazardous air pollutants (HAPS) on a 12 month rolling time period.

During this inspection, emission records had several deficiencies. Several corrections and submittals were subsequently provided over time but problems still remain. In addition to the violation cited above, the records lack appropriate units and nomenclature.

The conditions of PTI number 52-00C require maintenance of records, which shall be made available for review upon request by the AQD staff.

Please initiate actions necessary to correct the cited violations and submit a written response to this Violation Notice by July 21. The written response should include: the

dates the violations occurred; an explanation of the causes and duration of the violations; whether the violations are ongoing; a summary of the actions that have been taken and are proposed to be taken to correct the violations and the dates by which these actions will take place; and what steps are being taken to prevent a reoccurrence.

If Enviro Tech Coatings believes the above observations or statements are inaccurate or do not constitute violations of the applicable legal requirements cited, please provide appropriate factual information to explain your position.

Thank you for your attention to resolving the violations cited above and for the cooperation that was extended to me during my inspection of March 9, 2016.
