The Pack Bed Scrubber at PPI Aerospace, Groesbeck location, under permit PTI 294-00D, is required to run a water element at a minimum of 150 gallons per minute and incurred a violation due to absence of records of use and malfunction during time of DEQ audit.

- Dates the violations occurred: Unfortunately a paper trail is still missing to indicate exact dates.
- An explanation of the causes and duration of the violations: Equipment failures and/or
 malfunctions are the cause of the violation. The duration of exact onset is unknown due to
 missing paper trail, but the issue has been corrected.
- Whether the violations are ongoing-The violation is corrected.
- A summary of the actions that have been taken and are proposed to be taken to correct the
 violations: Running of the water element for the Pack Bed Scrubber; Implementation of daily
 checks for function and any issues addressed in a timely manner. Personnel have been trained
 in what is required and necessary according to PTI 294-OOD.
- The dates by which these actions will take place: Longer-term solutions and actions began
 approximately four months ago and PPI is currently running as deemed necessary under
 permit.
- What steps are being taken to prevent a reoccurrence: PPI has reconfigured/ relocated
 differential gages which is expected to reduce future maintenance issues associated with an
 older control panel. Parallel/ back up pumps for circulation of both sides are being overhauled.

PPI endeavors to be in full compliance with Environmental Standards.
