I arrived at the facility and met with Greg Mosley. I gave him the Environmental Inspections pamphlet and explained the purpose of my visit. This facility operates under a General Permit to Install #35-02, which covers coating lines (up to 10 tons/year VOCS). Greg showed me that they take used 20 lbs. propane cylinders and scrape the old paint off it and repaint it to be used again. They have an automated coating line with HVLP spray applicators that the cylinders are loaded on to where they are sprayed and then dried. The overspray is controlled by filters that they change on a daily basis. They also have a shot cleaner that they use on the more rusted cylinders, but it was not running at the time of the inspection. The cleaning device is controlled with a dust collector.

He then showed me the records that they are required to keep. They have a limit of 2,000 lbs/month of VOC and for February, 2014 they emitted 0.42 tons (840 lbs.). They also have a limit of 10 tons/year of VOC and for the period of March, 2013 through February, 2014, they emitted 8 tons.

Based on the information gathered during the inspection and their MAERS submittal, I determined that they are in compliance with their permit.
