SUBJECT: Response to Violation Notice, Advanced Technology 'Services, Incorporated (ATS),

Wayne County

Site Identification Number: MIK 779 772 698

This letter is in response to air inspection conducted on July 2, 2019 and subsequent letter dated August 2, 2019 noting the violations listed below. Evidence of corrective measures closing each item follows the finding.

1. **EUBURNOFF:** PTI 95-03, Special Condition (SC) 1.14 requires that "exhaust gases from EUBURNOFF shall be discharged unobstructed vertically upwards to the ambient air." During the inspection it was observed that stack is obstructed with the installation of a rain cap. This is a violation of PTI 95-03, SC 1.14.

Response: A replacement cap has been ordered which will be unobstructed directly to the atmosphere.

2. **Torch Type Burn-Off Unit**: During the inspection on July 2, 2019, it was noted that ATS had installed a torch type burn-off unit. This is a violation of R 336.1201 (Rule 201) of the administrative rules promulgated under Act 451.

Response: The unit was determined to be not necessary to the operations. The unit has been disconnect and removed from service.
