VIOLATION NOTICE

Staff from the Michigan Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ) Air Quality Division (AQD) visited the Klimek, Stawowy, Wojtowicz crude oil production facility located near Sterling, Michigan on September 4, 2014. The purpose of the visit was to determine your facility's compliance with the requirements of the federal Clean Air Act as well as Part 55, Air Pollution Control, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended (Act 451) and air use permit to install (PTI) 273-07.

During site visit, staff determined the following:

Crude oil production facility	PTI 273-07 FGfacility Condition 4.5	Shut down system inoperable as Murphy switch was disconnected at the Klimek wellhead.
	PTI 273-07 FGfacility Condition 4.8 visible emissions records	Records requested but the request was unfulfilled.
	PTI 273-07 FGfacility Condition 4.9 SO2 emissions calculations / records	Records requested but the request was unfulfilled.

The conditions of PTI number 273-07 require maintenance of records, which shall be made available for review upon request by the AQD staff. Please note records were initially requested August 29, 2014 and again September 4, 2014 without response.

Please initiate actions necessary to correct the cited violations and submit a written response to this Violation Notice by October 6, 2014 (which coincides with 21 calendar days from the date of this letter). The written response should include: the dates the violations occurred; an explanation of the causes and duration of the violations; whether the violations are ongoing; a summary of the actions that have been taken and are

proposed to be taken to correct the violations and the dates by which these actions will take place; and what steps are being taken to prevent a reoccurrence.

If Muskegon Development Company believes the above observations or statements are inaccurate or do not constitute violations of the applicable legal requirements cited, please provide appropriate factual information to explain your position.
