RESOLVED COMPLAINTS:		

On Wednesday April 8, 2015 I conducted an unannounced, scheduled inspection of Speedway SuperAmerica #5543 (Speedway); located at 8185 Commerce Road in Commerce Township, Michigan. The purpose of the inspection was to determine the facility's compliance with the federal Clean Air Act, Part 55, Air Pollution Control, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended.

Air Quality Division files show that Speedway's Permit to Install (PTI) No. 147-08 was voided on May 9, 2013 because the combined air sparge and soil vapor extraction system at the gas station was shut down and disconnected. I met with Brianna, Speedway's manager, who explained that ATC had been the consulting company responsible for the remediation and that the remediation trailer had not been on site since the facility had undergone a renovation. I saw no trailer or monitoring wells at the facility.

I spoke with Ms. Emily Bertolini, Environmental Quality Analyst of the MDEQ Remediation and Redevelopment Division (RRD), who confirmed that Cardno ATC was Speedway's consulting company and that the site remediation system was shut down in the first quarter of 2013. According to Mr. Joshua Schuyler, Senior Project Manager at Cardno, the system was shut down on February 27, 2013, and removed from site along with all wells and components during the site raze and rebuild on August 13, 2014. There are no future plans to re-install a system at the site.

Gasoline storage and handling equipment at Speedway appears to be exempt from permitting requirements via R 284(g)(i).

Compliance Demonstration

As a result of the inspection, it appears that Speedway is in compliance with the federal Clean Air Act, Part 55, Air Pollution Control, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended.
