Mr. Hemben,

This letter is in response to a violation notice dated October 4<sup>th</sup>, 2013 regarding fugitive dust at the 25435 Outer Dr. site. In reference to the notice, GLE has determined that the fugitive dust in question is being tracked on to the road by trucks leaving the site. We have decided that the best way to remedy the fugitive material with the onset of winter is to contract a street sweeping company to clean not only the paved driveway section of the site, but also the area of the road on Outer Dr. prior to our entrance continuing past our entrance where the area of concern has been noted, both by yourself and our operations manager on site. The street sweeping will be maintained year round and should eliminate the source of the material of concern. Street sweeping measures are to begin immediately and will happen with a weekly frequency. The operations manager shall inspect to be sure that the sweeping has been performed and note the date and action on a new dust control log that has been created.

GLE will reevaluate dust control measures required periodically to address any new concerns as site conditions or seasonal conditions change. Any new action will be implemented as necessary, along with dates and measures used recorded on the dust control log.
