Please accept this letter as written response to violation notice SRN: P0676, Ionia County.

Back in March of 2014, Wiesen Inc. purchased a coating burn off oven from a powder coat company going out of business. The burn off oven was installed shortly after purchase. On December 16, 2015, it was brought to Wiesen Inc.'s attention by Eric Grinstern that the installation of the oven without a permit was a violation of Act 451, Rule 201. Therefore, this violation occurred due to Wiesen Inc. being unaware that an installation permit was needed. The oven has been in use since March of 2014.

On January 14, 2016, Wiesen Inc. purchased a refurbished oven from Jackson Oven Supply, Inc. The new oven was refurbished to meet all Michigan standards, including the high fire afterburner. On January 15, 2016, Wiesen Inc. spoke with a licensed HVAC contractor, Shelley Cooper from Cooper Mechanical, and hired her to obtain all necessary permits needed to install the new oven. Once all necessary permits have been obtained, Shelley Cooper will also install the new oven. Wiesen Inc. is hopeful to have all necessary permits approved and the new oven installed in February of 2016.

Once the new oven has been installed, the existing oven will be disposed of.

For all future Powder Coat machinery installations, Wiesen Inc. will first inquire as to whether a permit is needed. If a permit is needed, Wiesen Inc. will take all necessary steps to obtain a permit prior to installing the equipment.
