Unannounced inspection of Wiesen Powder Coat.

The primary purpose of the inspection was to investigate a complaint received regarding smoke and odors.

Wiesen Powder Coating is located adjacent to Wiesen Inc. Upon arrival at the facility staff was informed that the President, Jeff Wiesen was away from the office, as was the manager of Wiesen Powder Coat, Jarrod Wiesen. Staff was escorted by Scott Gladding on a tour of Wiesen Powder Coat. The facility coats wheels via a powder coating operation. The facility has a wash booth, powder coating booth and a cure over. The coating booth and cure oven are exempt from permitting under Rule 287(d). The facility also has a small paint burn-off oven (approximately 8'x6'x4' in size). The facility uses the oven to burn the coating off of wheels. The unit is old and staff did not observe any operational temperature recorders for the unit or afterburner. The burn-off oven has a stack that does not extend above the highest roof line of the facility and has a stack cap. This unit is the cause of the odor and smoke complaints.

Staff spoke with Jeff Wiesen, President on December 21, 2015. Staff informed Mr. Wiesen that the burnoff oven needed an air use permit prior to installation and that a Violation Notice would be issued. Mr. Wiesen had already started researching the permitting requirements for the unit and expressed the facilities desire to come into compliance with all applicable regulations.
