

RESPONSE TO VIOLATION

SRN: PO691 Permit to Install: 140-17



Date of Violation: August 20, 2018

The cause of fallout present at the neighboring property could have been caused by truck traffic and dumping of recycled materials at our 740 Ann St. location. The cause of the fallout to be present at the neighboring property is wind was out of the east and carried the fugitive dust. It should also be noted that neighboring properties and the city of Grand Rapids were preforming sweeping which also created a large amount of fugitive dust and could have contributed to the fallout on the neighboring property.

This violation is currently not ongoing.

Dynamic Crushing has taken the following steps to restrict this fallout of fugitive dust from effecting neighboring properties in the future. A sprinkling system has been installed across the entire length of the property to keep haul roads and stock piles moist to prevent the wind from making the dust airborne. Dynamic Crushing has also purchased a street sweeping attachment for our skidsteer. The sweeper has a bristle broom that is in an enclosed housing and sweeps the dirt and debris into the bucket; containing all of the fugitive materials. To help further eliminate the risk of future fallout carrying to neighboring properties; Dynamic Crushing will monitor the wind speed and direction and will limit crushing operations as need be per the conditions.
